

MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMPOUT! This is always a highlight every summer.

PICKUP – Friday morning between 7:30 am – 9:00 am. THERE IS NO regular camp day for middle schoolers on Friday Aug 1st.

General Camp Information: Students will stay at camp on Thursday evening until Friday morning. Dinner will be provided. Lots of fun games and glow in the dark activities, bonfire, devotion and breakfast provided. Students will need to bring their items to camp on Thursday morning. We will be playing games and activities late into the night Thursday evening. They will want a flashlight for these activities. Girls and Boys will have separate camp site areas and bathroom areas. Campers who do not abide by our campout rules will be sent home immediately.

Things to bring:

Sleeping Bag,

pillow

toothpaste / toothbrush

change of clothes (sweatshirt/sweatpants for chilly morning&evening)

flashlight. (phones not acceptable as flashlights)

bible(we have some here if they don't bring one)

Tent - Camper can bring their own or use one of ours. Counselors will be discussing sleeping arrangements with campers throughout the week. We will make sure friends are grouped together and make sure everyone has a tent available. They may also sleep in an Enu if they prefer (must provide their own). There will be different camp sites for boys and girls. *Please let us know if you have any questions about sleeping arrangements.

NO CELL PHONES or devices will be allowed. They will be allowed to call home at anytime using a camp phone. If you need to check on your camper, please free to call or text us on the camp cell phone.at 336-477-4122.

MEDICATIONS: If your camper needs medications at night or early morning, please contact the office to arrange this. Campers are NOT allowed to have prescription medications in their bag.

Behavior is a contingency on being about to participate. If students have discipline issues through the week, they will not be allowed to stay for an overnight campout. Thank you for understanding.

My camper has practice/ballgame/etc. Can they leave camp on Thursday and return for the campout? YES, please contact office to arrange this.

My camper needs medications at night, how do you handle this? Please contact office

What happens if my camper gets scared or wants to come home? If a camper decides they do not want to stay, we will call parents or have them call you. We want every camper to have a good time, therefore if they are upset or wanting to go home, we will allow them to call home at any time. We of course will encourage them to stay at first, but if they still don't want to stay, we will call home.
